

Elementary School Supplies Lists 2015-16

Please label all items with your child's name, unless otherwise noted.

Additional items may be requested by individual teachers at the start of the year.

All students are required to have a pair of clean gym shoes to be kept at school.

DK Supplies

1—Backpack - large, zippered backpack suitable for library books, art projects and winter gear.

Please, no wheeled backpacks.

1—Lunch container - with child's name written on it, if bringing *cold* lunch from home

4—Large glue sticks (.77 oz) - Ross and Elmer's are quality brands

1—Box of tissues

Please note: Students do NOT need a pencil box, ruler or scissors. Please do not label glue sticks with your child's name.

Kindergarten Supplies

1—Backpack - large, zippered backpack suitable for library books, art projects and winter gear. **Please, no wheeled backpacks.**

1—Lunch container - with child's name written on it, if bringing *cold* lunch from home

2—Solid colored, plastic, 2 pocket folders

4—Large (.77 oz.) glue sticks

2—8 pack of washable markers

1—Pack of fat dry erase markers

2—Boxes of Crayola crayons (16 or 24, please no "Beginner" crayons)

1—Package of napkins (Only boys need to bring)

1—Box of tissues (Only girls need to bring)

Please note: Students do NOT need a pencil box, ruler or scissors. Please do not label crayons, glue sticks, markers or folders with your child's name.

Please do not label pencils, tissues or glue sticks.

1—Box of Kleenex (girls)

1—box of latex free Band-Aids (boys)

4—thin dry erase markers

4—Large glue sticks

2—Large erasers

24—#2 pencils (Dixon or Sanford)

Third Grade Supplies

4—**COMPOSITION** notebooks (**WIDE RULED**)

1—Pencil box

Washable markers (any size)

1—Three ring view binder (one inch size, with clear pocket insert on cover and interior pockets)

1—Used, clean sock (to be used as a whiteboard eraser)

4—**FINE TIP** dry erase markers (any color)

48—Pencils (Dixon or Sanford), cheaper pencils are quickly eaten by our classroom sharpeners
