Please label all items with your child's name, unless otherwise noted.

Additional items may be requested by individual teachers at the start of the year.

## All students are required to have a pair of clean gym shoes to be kept at school.

#### **DK** Supplies

1—Backpack - large, zippered backpack suitable for library books, art projects and winter gear.

#### Please, no wheeled backpacks.

- 1—Lunch container with child's name written on it, if bringing *cold* lunch from home
- 4—Large glue sticks (.77 oz) Ross and Elmer's are quality brands
- 1—Box of tissues

<u>Please note:</u> Students <u>do NOT need</u> a pencil box, ruler or scissors. Please <u>do not</u> label glue sticks with your child's name.

## Kindergarten Supplies

- 1—Backpack large, zippered backpack suitable for library books, art projects and winter gear. <u>Please</u>, no wheeled backpacks.
- 1—Lunch container with child's name written on it, if bringing cold lunch from home
- 2—Solid colored, plastic, 2 pocket folders
- 4-Large (.77 oz.) glue sticks
- 2-8 pack of washable markers
- 1—Pack of fat dry erase markers
- 2—Boxes of Crayola crayons (16 or 24, please no "Beginner" crayons)
- 1—Package of napkins (Only boys need to bring)
- 1—Box of tissues (Only girls need to bring)
