Electronic Devices Reminder

This is Evergreen's personal electronic devices policy, which is aligned for consistency across the K-8 buildings, states:

"Evergreen students will not be permitted to have personal electronic devices out during the school day, including **cell phones, smartwatches, and tablets, among others.** Preferably, these items would remain at home, however, if a student brings a device, it should be turned off and left in their backpack during school hours. If personal electronic devices are observed by staff they may be confiscated and turned in to the office. Parents will then be asked to make arrangements with the office to pick up the device."

Over the next couple of weeks, the district's school buildings will participate in a district-wide School Safety Week. Throughout that week, all buildings and departments will practice each of our district safety drills. Students' safety and well-being are of the utmost importance to us, and we look forward to increasing their awareness of the procedures we would take in a variety of emergency situations.
