School Meals Participation

We served 206,855 student meals, in addition to staff and ala carte meals, which reflects an increase in school meal participation of 1902 meals from 2009-2010.

25% of our students qualified for free meals and 7% for reduced priced meals. Our percentage of free applications on file reflects an increase of 2% from last year. The percentage of reduced applications on file decreased by 1% from last year.
