Reconfirm instructional delivery method:

Reconfirm how instruction will be delivered for each grade level:

Pre-Kindergarten: Option #1 (Face-to-Face) and Option #2 (Remote)

Elementary (Grades K - 5): Option #1 (Face-to-Face), Option #2 (Remote), and Option #3 (Online)

Middle School (Grades 6 - 8): Option #1 (Face-to-Face), Option #2 (Remote), and Option #3 (Online)

High School (Grades 9 - 12): Option #1 (Face-to-Face), Option #2 (Remote), and Option #3 (Online)

Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:
