Allendale Middle School Annual Education Report

Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2021-22 educational progress for Allendale Middle School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2021-22 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2021-22. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67% in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school was not identified under ESSA requirements.

This is a very exciting time for Allendale Middle School! We are implementing best practices designed to improve student achievement, specifically proficiency in reading and math. One of those best practices is the implementation of the i-Ready program. This program is designed to personalize a study routine to improve students' individual needs. This will increase the number of students who are "proficient" or "at grade level" in reading and math and strengthen the skills of those students who are already "proficient." i-Ready has shown a direct correlation to M-STEP scores. We are confident that implementing this program with fidelity will increase proficiency in reading and math on the M-STEP. As students become more proficient as readers and mathematicians, this work will also positively affect other academic areas.

All students in grades six through eight were assigned to Allendale Middle School.

Allendale is in year two of our five-year school improvement plan. Allendale Middle School focuses on improving performance in math, reading, science, and social studies.

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Allendale Public Schools currently operates one specialized alternative education high school (New Options High School). All other schools in the district are not specialized.

Fall 2020-2021 = (37%) students were represented by parents/guardians at fall conferences.
