## **Graduation Ceremony**

Tickets are <u>not</u> required to attend the graduation ceremony; however, it is important to know that the AHS gymnasium does have a seating capacity. Seating is on a first come, first served basis. Any guest overflow will be directed to our Ceglarek Fine Arts Center (CFAC) where the graduation ceremony will be live streamed. # **Graduation Announcements/Caps and Gowns/etc.**

These items will be handed out to students at school on Friday, April 21 during our lunch period. Any student who needs to order any graduation supplies needs to place the order directly with Jostens at 1.877.475.7027.

#### **Baccalaureate Service**

A Baccalaureate service has been planned by a student committee and will be hosted by **Wellspring Church**. This ceremony will take place on Sunday, May 21, at 2 pm. This is a voluntary church service for graduates. Those who attend are asked to wear their graduation gown and stole but not their caps. Students who choose to attend are asked to arrive one-half hour prior to the start of the program.

# **Graduation Day/Ceremony/Rehearsal**

Graduation will take place on Thursday, May 25, at 7:00 PM in the high school gymnasium. Rehearsal for students, which is mandatory, will begin in the gym at 7:45 AM that same morning. Rehearsal will last until 9:30 AM. On the evening of graduation, graduates should arrive no later than 6:15 PM and meet in the CFAC for graduation preparation. We will be taking a class picture at that time. The graduation committee has requested that jeans and tennis shoes not be worn on graduation day. Please note: Only senior students fulfilling the requirements for graduation up to and including their last day of school on May 12 will be eligible to take part in the graduation ceremony. Social issues (skipping school, "Senior Pranks," etc.,) that may take place between now and graduation could result in the loss of the privilege to take part in the graduation ceremony.

## Senior Exams/Last Day of School for Seniors

Senior Exams will take place Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday, May 15-17. Seniors who are required to take exams must attend on these dates. Individual teachers will determine exam requirements based on student grades and attendance. The final "regular" day for seniors will be Friday, May 12, assuming cooperation from the senior class both socially and in attendance (no senior prank and no senior skip day). Those seniors who do not have to take an exam are not required to attend school during exam periods on May 15, 16, and 17.

### **Senior Honors Convocation**

The Seniors Honors Convocation will take place on Monday, May 22, in the Ceglarek Fine Arts Center. The program will begin at 7:00 p.m. Scholarships and departmental awards will be presented. Honorees will receive a written invitation for the event. We ask that all honorees dress appropriately and not wear t-shirts, jeans, shorts, or sandals. - · If there are other children in the household, Food Service will transfer money to the sibling account once your senior has finished classes.
- · If the remaining balance is over \$ 5.00, a check will be mailed.
- · If the remaining balance is under \$ 5.00, a cash refund will be given to the student on the day of graduation practice.
- · Or, you may reply to the email and donate the remaining funds to Food Service to be used to help another family.
