



Background:

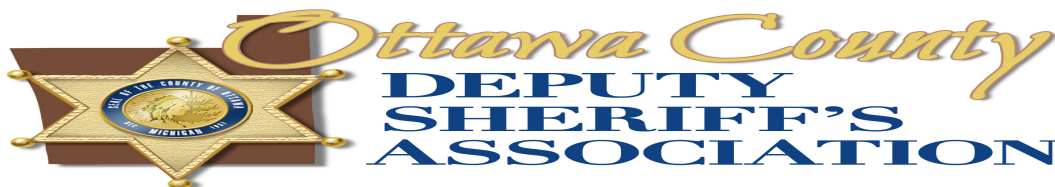
The \$4,000.00 scholarship is named after Deputy David Steenwyk and Deputy Matt Chatfield and was established in 2005 by the Ottawa County Deputy Sheriff's Association. Deputy Steenwyk was employed for over 25 years with the Ottawa County Sheriff's Department. He worked as a corrections deputy and a road patrol deputy during his years of service. He tragically passed away from a brain aneurysm before he could retire. Deputy Matt Chatfield was employed for 15 years as a road patrol deputy with the Ottawa County Sheriff's Office. He tragically passed after a yearlong battle with colon cancer. This scholarship will be awarded yearly in their honor to a high school senior pursuing a career in criminal justice. The scholarship is worth up to \$4,000.00, \$1,000.00 will be awarded yearly with the scholarship being renewable up to four years.

Qualifications:

This scholarship is open to Ottawa County high school seniors who are accepted into a two or four year college or university. The student must major in criminal justice. The scholarship is renewable up to four years. Student must show proof of major and maintain a 3.0 GPA in order to be eligible to renew scholarship. Applicants must fill out entire application and provide an essay on why he/she are applying for the scholarship, career plans, general personal background, and any other information the applicant feels is important. Applicants must also provide proof of high school GPA, ACT/SAT scores, and acceptance letter from college with application. ***Any application not filled out entirely or missing paperwork will not be considered.*** Applications will be reviewed by a committee of at least three deputies from the Ottawa County Deputy Sheriff's Association. The committee will select finalists to be interviewed. Applicants will be notified in writing of the committee's decision. More than one student may be selected, depending on funding amounts on that particular calendar year.
