SUBJECT: Police Community Relations Criminal Justice Scholarship

The Holland Police Community Relations Commission announces a \$2,000.00, non-renewable, scholarship for area students who are currently enrolled or are enrolling in a post-secondary Criminal Justice program or track. In keeping with the purpose of the Commission, the group is committed to encouraging and assisting students desiring to become law enforcement officers. The scholarship will be awarded annually in the spring to one individual who reflects the highest potential for law enforcement.

The Police Community Relations Commission is committed to diversity and strongly encourages minority and female students to apply.

To receive full consideration, the student applicant must be a resident of the greater Holland area (applicants who reside within the Holland City limits shall be considered first over nonresidents), receive their high school diploma in the spring of 2022, have a cumulative 3.00 GPA or higher, be accepted or currently enrolled in a higher education institution intending to pursue a degree in Criminal Justice, and have an acceptable background check and driving record. The Commission will consider an applicant with less than a 3.00 GPA if the other criteria are met and the student shows considerable potential for a career in law enforcement.

The attached application and supplementary materials must be postmarked by **May 31, 2022**. A complete application contains the following materials:

- The application form
- An essay on why you desire to enter the law enforcement profession and the characteristics you have that will make you a successful law enforcement officer. The essay should be limited to no more than two pages, double-spaced.
- An official high school or college transcript
- Two letters of recommendation (only one may be from a teacher)

Finalists may be expected to participate in a conversation with members of the Police Community Relations Commission. The members will discuss the finalists' interest in the scholarship and the content of their essay.
