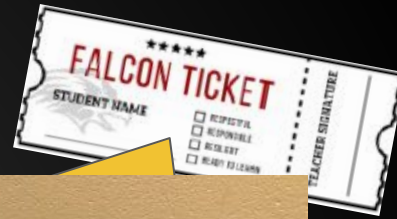

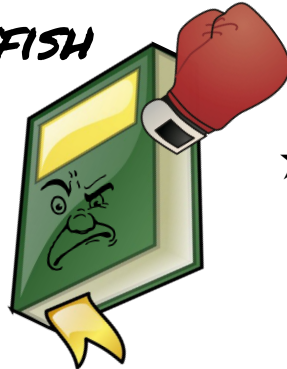

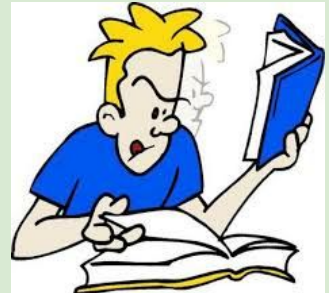
Do I have to sign up to attend? Yes - Sign ups on google form than can be found in the announcements. Sign up by 12:30 the day you plan to attend.
