Falcon Four Recognition: Emma, Tinley, Cayleigh

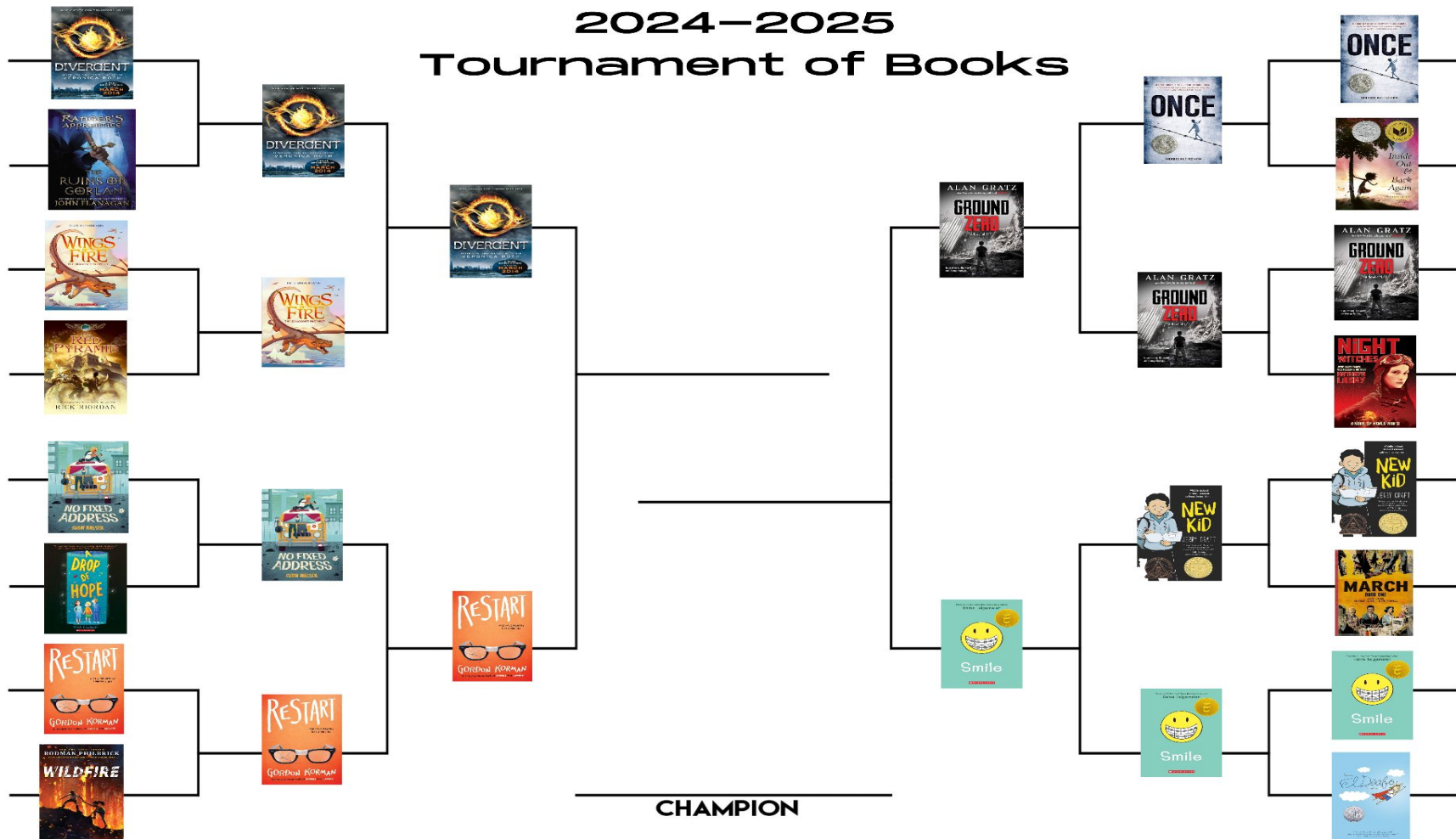
