



Download Videos from Youtube


Use this guide to download and install DownloadHelper Firefox Plugin to enable you to download videos from Youtube.

- Open Firefox
- Go to:

- Click the green **Add to Firefox** button

- Wait 4 seconds for the **Install Now** button to become available then click on **Install Now**.
- The plugin will automatically install.



- You will be prompted to restart FireFox to complete the install, please click the **Restart Firefox** button. Once Firefox restarts the plugin install is complete.

- Open your favorite Youtube video, near the title of your video is the DownloadHelper icon, click this and it will automatically begin downloading your Youtube video. The default download location is to a folder **dwhelper** on your desktop.
- Once the file is downloaded you can then upload it to Moodle, play on your computer, etc.
